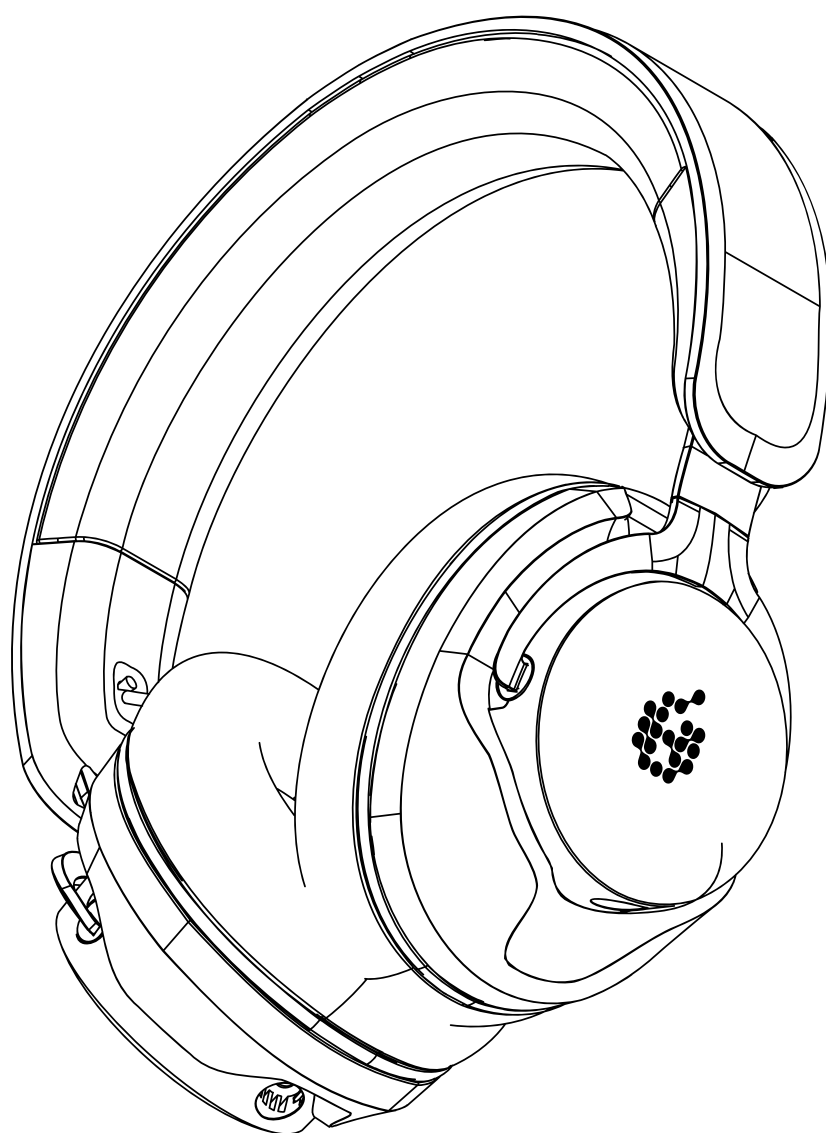

- Do not use this product in an environment where your hearing abilities are needed.

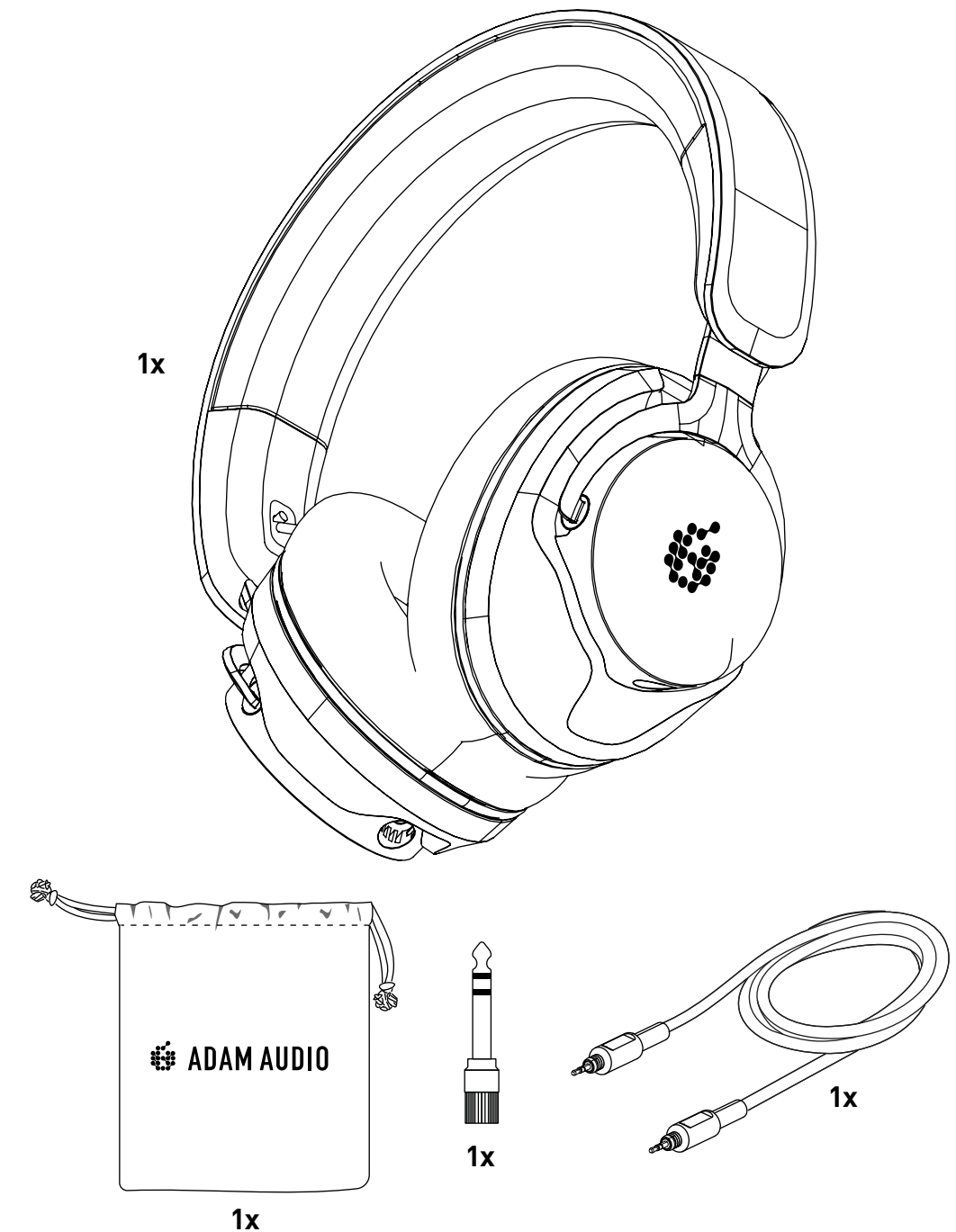
Health

- This headphone can generate sound pressure levels in excess of 85 dB(A). High sound levels may damage your hearing! Sound exposure is a function of time and level. Longer times and lower levels can be equivalent to shorter times and higher levels. Exercise caution when using this product.
- The product generates stronger static magnetic fields which may affect pacemakers or implanted defibrillators.

Preventing damage to the product

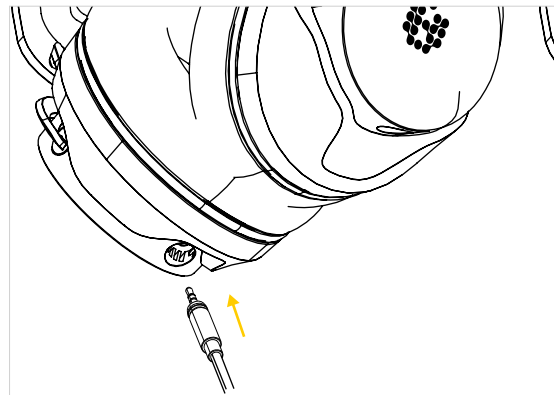
- Do not expose this product to rain or moisture, never wet the product with any liquid and never pour or spill liquids directly onto this unit.
- Never expose this product to extremely high or low temperatures.
- Do not place product in direct sunlight.
- Only use a dry lint-free cloth for cleaning.

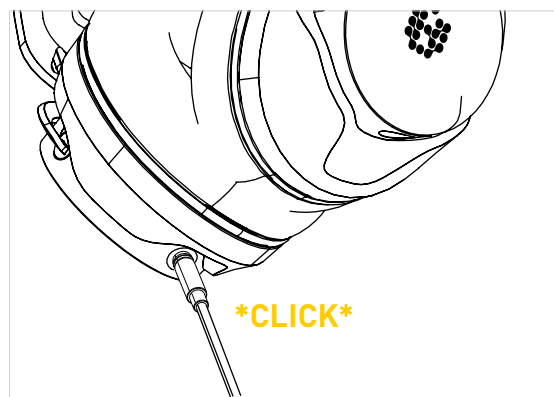


3. ATTACHING THE CONNECTION CABLE

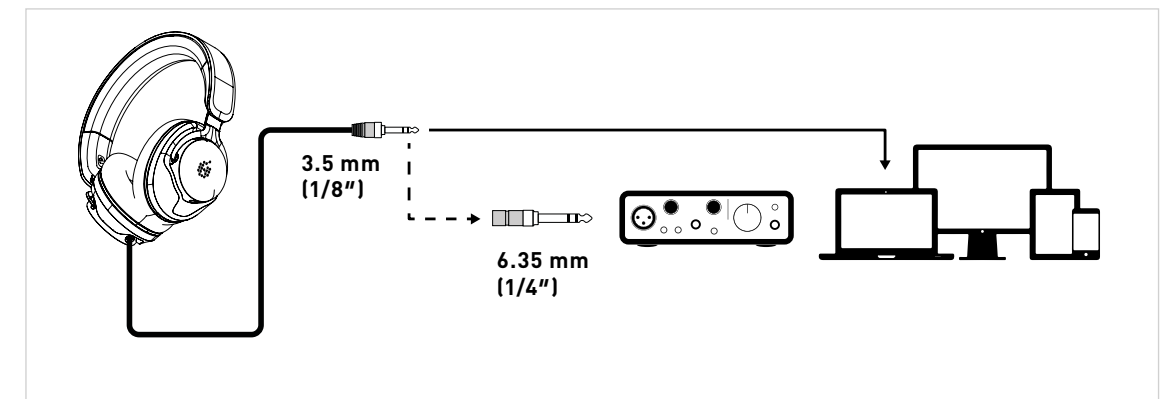
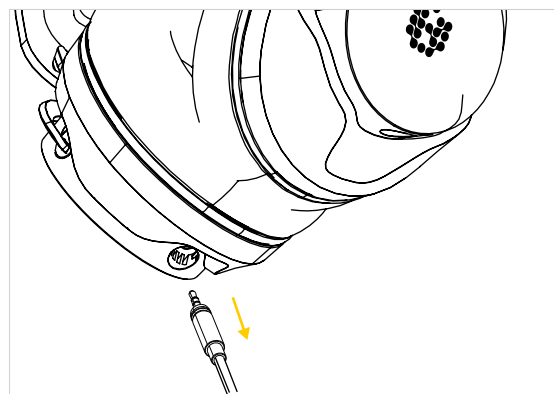
- Attach the included connection cable either to the left or the right ear cup.



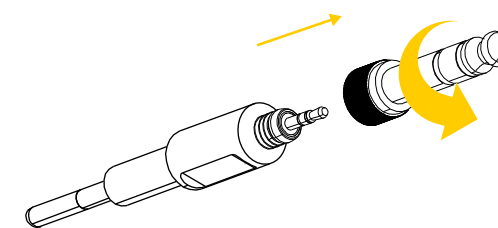
- Insert the connection cable into one of the connectors until it locks into place with an audible click.



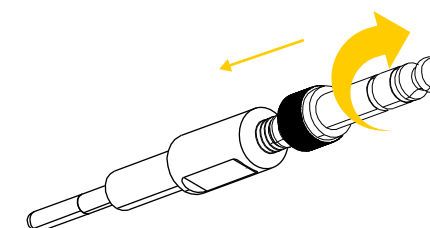
- To remove or replace the cable, pull it gently out of the connector using the barrel of the jack connector, not the cable.



- Connect the H200 to the headphones output of e.g. a dedicated headphone amplifier, the headphone output of your audio interface, mixer, portable listening device or computer.
- Use the included **3.5 mm to 6.3 mm adapter** if needed.
- Detach the adapter from the cable by turning it anticlockwise.



- Attach the adapter to the cable by turning it clockwise.



4. USING THE H200

- Make sure to position the H200 correctly on your head by checking the **L (left)** and **R (right)** markings in the earcups.



- Pull both ear cups down until they rest comfortably over your ears.



5. REPLACING THE EARPADS

- i** For hygiene reasons and because padding materials naturally degrade over time, earpads and the headband padding should be replaced occasionally. For headphones undergoing heavy use we recommend once a year, for medium and lighter use, once every two years is sufficient.

- To remove the earpads, simply pull firmly from the middle of the cushion until it has detached fully from the earcup.



- To replace the earpad, place it onto the earcup and start to slowly work the outer edge of the earpad into the groove.



- Hold the earpad and earcup with one hand and run your other index finger along the inside in a circle to attach the new earpad. Rotate until the letters align with the yoke.



6. REPLACING THE HEADBAND

- To remove the headband padding, simply pull firmly from the middle until it has fully clipped out of the headband.



- To replace the headband padding, insert one end into the end cap then clip the padding on the headband, starting from the inserted end and working towards the other. Insert the far end into the other end cap. You may need to open the headband wide to finish installing.



- After several clicks the replaced headband padding should sit flush with the headband again.
